# **COVID VACCINATION INFORMATION**

#### COVID BOOSTER DOSE – <u>At the Cinderford Vaccination Centre</u>

You can attend any of the walk in clinics for your booster dose at the Cinderford Vaccination Centre if it has been at least six months since your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. You can book an appointment for your booster at 5 months from the date of your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose – you will be offered appointment dates no earlier than six months after the date of your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. You can attend if you are:

- Aged 40 or over
- Aged 16 and over with a health condition that puts you at high risk from Covid you will need to bring your letter inviting you to get your booster dose or a letter from your doctor about your health condition. The earliest you can have your booster is 8 weeks or more from the date of your 2<sup>nd</sup> vaccination.
- A frontline health or social care worker you will need to bring proof of your employment such as your workplace photo ID, a letter or payslip from your employer dated within the last 3 months

All sessions are walk in or pre-booked appointment using the text message booking link sent to you by your Surgery.

Dates and times for the Cinderford Vaccination Centre are shown overleaf.

### FOR 1<sup>ST</sup> AND 2<sup>ND</sup> DOSES - <u>At the Cinderford Vaccination Centre</u>

Those eligible to attend are:

- Anyone aged 12 to 15 years for a 1st dose only
- Anyone aged 16 to 17 years for their 1<sup>st</sup> dose
- Anyone aged 16 to 17 years for their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose as long as it has been 12 weeks or more since the date of their 1<sup>st</sup> vaccination
- Anyone aged 18 years and over for their 1<sup>st</sup> dose
- Anyone aged 18 years and over for their 2<sup>nd</sup> dose as long as it has been 8 weeks or more since the date of their 1<sup>st</sup> vaccination

### COVID BOOSTER DOSE - Booking via the NHS National Booking Service

You can book your Covid booster dose online via the NHS National Booking Service if it has been 5 months (152 days) since you had your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose and you are:

- Aged 40 or over
- Aged 16 or over with a health condition that puts you at high risk from Covid.

PLEASE NOTE: These appointments will **NOT** be at the Cinderford Vaccination Centre. You CANNOT book an appointment online to go to Cinderford. Book your Appointment Online via the NHS National Booking Service (NOT at Cinderford)

You will be offered appointment dates from 6 months after the date of your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.

#### For 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Doses

You can attend any of the dates shown below as a walk in. You do not need a pre-booked appointment.

#### For Booster Doses

Please find the date of your 2<sup>nd</sup> dose in the 1<sup>st</sup> column. The date shown in the 2<sup>nd</sup> column is the earliest date that you can go to the Cinderford Vaccination Centre for your booster vaccination. You can just go along, you do not need a pre-booked appointment.

#### IF YOU HAVE HAD COVID RECENTLY

If you have had Covid recently, you will need to wait 28 days from the date of your positive test or from when your symptoms started before having your 1<sup>st</sup> dose, 2<sup>nd</sup> dose or booster vaccination.

If you are aged 12-17 and have had Covid recently, you will need to wait 12 weeks from the date of your positive test or from when your symptoms started before having your 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> dose.
